Community Days- Mr. Monks discussed some items regarding Community Days. The Clarks accepted an offer of \$15,000 to perform on Saturday night. We are waiting for final details of the agreement. Best Buy will be involved and will be having a Guitar Hero Challenge where their employees will play the game and residents can challenge their scores for prizes and a final competition. Mr. Monks informed the board after some discussion about the Clarks expenditure, that there are commitments of about \$15-18,000 for sponsorships in addition to the \$4,500 already in. The committee is working to secure more entertainment. He told the Board that a meeting had been held with the Pyrotechnico and Windswept to review the site.

Mr. Brozovich informed the Board that he had met with the fire dept. regarding the parade and they were on board and offered to organize the staging area. They will also host a post parade party for all participating units.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT- Mr. Dantley asked Mr. Brozovich if we could order a new volleyball net for the Friday program. It will be done.
