Thomas Will stated that the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board requires a municipal resolution approving the transfer since it's a place to place transfer. The license is being transferred from Juicie Inc. at 301 North Craig Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15213 to Amit Aggarwal owner of Swaad Cuisines, LLC DBA Paprika's.

Mr. Morosetti asked if there was a business in there now and what the seating capacity is.

Amit Aggarwal said there is a restaurant/pizza shop and the seating capacity is 97.
