

**NORTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC HEARING
JUNE 8, 2021
6:30 P.M.**

A public hearing was held on Tuesday, June 8, 2021, with Board of Supervisors Chairman Jim Morosetti presiding for the purpose of taking public comment on the following:

To consider the request of BHC Oakdale, LLC D/B/A The Goose Express to transfer a restaurant liquor license (NO. R-12796) from Shaler Township, Allegheny County, PA, to 7851 Steubenville Pike, North Fayette Township.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called with the following present: Chairman Jim Morosetti, Vice Chairman J.R. Mangan, Treasurer Bob Doddato (absent), Township Manager Michael Baker, Chief of Police Donald Cokus (absent), Solicitor Michele Cromer, and Township Secretary Marlyn Jordan.

OTHERS PRESENT: Andrew Hartwell – Community Development Director, Kevin Brett – Township Engineer, Leah Attanucci – Court Reporter, and Tim Burke.

Tim Burke from Cooked Goose stated that they are trying to get a liquor license transferred for take-out and to service weddings.

Mr. Morosetti wanted to know if they would be serving liquor, beer, and wine.

Mr. Burke stated that it would be beer and some wine. For weddings they would offer a full bar.

Mr. Mangan wanted to know if they acquire the license if they can take it to other places for the weddings.

Mr. Burke stated yes as long as it's in the state of Pennsylvania.

Mr. Hartwell wanted to know if they plan on putting seating at their location by Choice Cigarettes.

Mr. Burke said no. They are planning to put in a place by the magistrate's office.

Mr. Morosetti asked if they were no longer at the Oakdale Diner.

Mr. Burke said no that they sold that 5 years ago.

Mr. Morosetti stated that the board has 45 days to make a decision on this hearing.
