

**NORTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing was held on Tuesday, July 28, 2020 with Board of Supervisors Chairman Jim Morosetti presiding for the purpose of taking public comment on the following:

The request of Eaton Pizza, Inc. D/B/A Angelia's Pizza to transfer a restaurant liquor license (No. R-2497) from McKees Rocks, PA, Kennedy Township to 410 Penn Lincoln Drive, Imperial, PA 15126, North Fayette Township.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance roll was called with the following present: Chairman Jim Morosetti, Vice Chairman J.R. Mangan, Treasurer Bob Doddato, Chief of Police Mark O'Donnell, Solicitor Michele Cromer, and Township Secretary Marlyn Jordan.

All people wishing to speak were sworn in by the Township Manager.

David Eaton stated that they wish to transfer a liquor license from McKees Rocks to North Fayette Township. They will be selling six packs to go. They will have only beer.

Mr. Morosetti wanted to know where the license is coming from. Mr. Eaton said they are transferring it from another Angelia's in McKees Rocks.

Mr. Doddato wanted to know if they would eventually add a bar. Mr. Eaton said that they have no interest in adding a bar.

Mr. Morosetti asked if there were any other comments. Being none, he stated that the board has 45 days to make a decision on this hearing.
