

**NORTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP  
PUBLIC HEARING  
AUGUST 10, 2021  
6:30 P.M.**

A Public Hearing was held on Tuesday, August 10, 2021, with Board of Supervisors Chairman Jim Morosetti presiding for the purpose of taking public comment on the following:

Proposed Ordinance No. 477, an ordinance authorizing the Township to enter into a cable franchise agreement with Verizon Pennsylvania, LLC for the provision of cable communications services in the Township and establishing franchise fees to be paid to the Township and other provisions of the proposed agreement.
