Waterway Pollution Reduction Plan

Why is water quality important? Fresh water is one of our most vital resources and comes from rivers, lakes, and other surface water sources. Managing storm water not only helps with flooding, but it can also help make our waterways a cleaner environment for all. There are many streams in North Fayette Township that are classified as “impaired” by the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). The Township has been under a strict permit to improve our waterways since 2003 and will renew the permit March 2018. Under the new permit, municipalities around the state are required to implement a Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP).

The PRP for North Fayette requires that the Township reduce the amount of sediment put into our waterways by 10% over the next five years. Not so fun fact: In North Fayette Township alone, approximately 1,260,000 pounds of sediment will enter our waterways in one year. That’s right, *just one year*. The PRP will require that we remove approximately 126,000 pounds of sediment per year. That seems like a daunting number, but the Township is confident the projects that are planned for the next five years will fulfill our requirements and better our streams.

In order to reduce our sediment loading by 126,000 pounds a year, several projects around the Township will need to be done. The PRP lists the projects as changes to 3 detention pond retrofits at the Pointe, installing a new detention area in Hankey Farms, retrofitting a detention facility in Pointe West, and a stream bank restoration project along North Road.

While the Township was utilizing monies on the other permits to be in compliance, this permit cycle will cost significantly more money.

To complete the aforementioned projects, it will cost the Township approximately \$740,000 over the next five years.
