## Every Pennsylvania Homeowner Needs to Worry about Radon

January is Radon Action Month and we are urging residents to test their homes for this silent but deadly killer. Winter is the best time to test for radon since homes are closed up and levels are at their peak.

As uranium decays in soil and rock beneath the Earth's surface, it produces radon, a naturally forming odorless, invisible, and radioactive gas that rises to the surface and mixes harmlessly with outdoor air. However, when it seeps through foundations and becomes trapped inside structures, radon levels can rise and become dangerous.

Radon exposure is the second leading cause of lung cancer, according to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the number one cause of lung cancer among non-smokers.

You can purchase test kits at home improvement and hardware stores, or call 1-800-SOS-RADON (1-800-767-7236).

Start with a short-term test which takes between 2-90 days. Homeowners should test for radon in the lowest level of their homes. Avoid testing in places that are damp, such as the kitchen, bathroom, or laundry room.

Trying a long-term test (longer than 90 days) is the best way to know what the level is over time. Be sure to test your home again after a remodeling project or after changes have been made to your heating, air, or ventilation systems.

If your home has a radon level of four or higher, it's time to take action. Be sure to hire a qualified contractor to do the repairs.

Due to increased operational costs, trash and recycling service fees have increased from \$15.00/month to \$16.50/month. The last time the Township made an adjustment was January 1, 2011. Even with the increase, our rate remains competitive with our neighbors: Findlay Twp. \$16.43, Robinson Twp. \$19.35, and Moon Twp. \$21.75 per month, respectively.
