

# North Fayette Summer Camp Health and Safety Plan

The program will be based entirely outdoors. The Community Center will only be used in the event of excessive heat (a heat index temperature of 103 degrees or greater) or inclement weather.

## COVID-19 NOTICE OF POTENTIAL CHANGES TO SUMMER CAMP

North Fayette summer camp shall adhere to all COVID-19 regulations of the CDC, Commonwealth of PA and Allegheny County. All regulations and guidelines of these entities are incorporated by reference and can change at any time. North Fayette Summer Camp reserves the right to amend its policies and procedures at anytime to address COVID-19 related matters, whether based on changes made by the CDC, Commonwealth of PA or Allegheny County or made at the discretion of North Fayette Township to best protect the health and safety of campers, staff and/or the community.

### Check-in

- Enter the drop off lane for your designated check-in point. Once you have reached the check-in point you will be asked a short series of screening questions, your child's temperature will be taken, and staff will check that your child has a mask with them. Upon completion, your child will exit your vehicle, sanitize his/her hands, and proceed to the designated area to join the appropriate group.
- This process will be similar to a carpool drop off/pick up lane. We will have cones and arrows to indicate the direction that traffic will progress. Please allow extra time for drop-off and pick-up.
- Check-in/pick-up points will be determined by your child's group area. Once your registration has been confirmed you will receive your child's group/area of the park, your check-in point and a map indicating the area of the parking lot in which it will be located.
- If you have more than one child participating in camp, we will determine your designated check-in/pick-up point based on number of participants using each.

If one child is in another area of the park, he/she will be escorted to the appropriate area by a member of the camp staff.

### Health Screening

- All campers and staff will complete a health screening upon arrival.
- Temperatures will be taken upon arrival and when deemed necessary. Persons found to have a temperature of 100.4 or higher, or any symptoms of illness will not be admitted to the program.
- If a campers or staff member is not admitted or sent home because of illness, he/she must be fever-free without the use of medication for 72 hours from the time they were sent home. The township reserves the right to require documentation from a professional healthcare provider that return to camp is recommended.
- If a camper becomes ill during the day, he/she will be isolated until a parent or other caregiver arrives. Please remain in your vehicle while your child is escorted to your vehicle.
- Campers must be picked up within one hour of parent notification for illness or any other reason. Failure to do so may result in suspension from the program.

### Pick-Up

- Please call ahead to the camp phone, 412-812-7116, or send a text message on the Remind app to alert us when you will be arriving. We will have your child/children waiting at your designated check-in/pick-up point.

### Groups

- Campers will be separated into four groups. Camp staff will be consistent throughout the program (minimum of 2 staff at all times).
- Campers will remain in their groups for the duration of the camp day and will not intermingle with other groups. Each group will function as an independent unit.

- Groups will be primarily based on campers' age. Campers may be assigned to another group if needed.
- Each group will have their own area of the park to use for activities consisting of a pavilion or tent structure and green space.

## Masks

- All participants are required to bring a reusable mask, clearly labeled with their first and last name, to camp each day. Masks are required at all times subject to current state and local mandates.
- Camp staff will be masked as required for the duration of the camp day.

## Handwashing/Sanitizing

- Campers will be required to wash their hands throughout the camp day.
  - Before and after eating.
  - After using restroom facilities.
  - Before and after applying sunscreen.
  - After sneezing, etc.
  - Before and after any activities in which there may be contact through supplies/equipment.
  - As necessary.
- We will have portable handwashing stations available as well as hand sanitizer.

## Sunscreen

- We encourage that you apply sunscreen to your child before arriving at camp. We will be applying sunscreen three times during the camp day.
- Due to safety concerns, we would prefer that you send individual, clearly labeled sunscreen for each participant. Please stress to your child the importance of not sharing their sunscreen with others.
- We would prefer sunscreen spray and face sticks in order to limit contact from staff.

## Bathrooms

- We will be using a staggered bathroom schedule throughout the day.
- Each group will have a key to a designated bathroom. Bathrooms will be locked to the public and reserved for camp use at this time.
- Bathrooms will be sanitized promptly following each use.

## Activities/Equipment

- Each group will have their own set of recreation equipment. This equipment will be disinfected after each use and at the end of the camp day.
- We will strive to do activities that have individual supplies for each camper. Any communal supplies (i.e., scissors, paint brushes, markers, etc.) will be sanitized between uses.
- We will strive to hold activities and recreation that limit physical contact and promote safe distancing.
- Playground equipment will only be utilized by one group at a time and sanitized after use and at the end of the camp day.

## Personal Items

- Please limit the number of items your child brings to camp. We would prefer that they only bring the items listed in the handbook that are required for camp each day, plus the required mask.
- All items should be clearly labeled and fit into a backpack also labeled with first and last names.
- Please do not allow your child to bring unnecessary items/toys from home.
