## **Community Center Masking Policy**

Due to the most recent Order from the PA Department of Health, all teachers, students, visitors, and/or staff associated with preschool and after school program shall be masked, subject to the specific exceptions set forth below:

1. If wearing a face covering would create an unsafe condition to operate equipment or execute a task for safety reasons.
2. If wearing a face covering would cause a medical condition or exacerbate an existing one.
3. When necessary to confirm an individual's identity.
4. When working alone or isolated from interaction with other people with little or no expectation of in-person interaction.
5. If seeking to communicate with someone who is hearing impaired or has another disability, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication.
6. When the individual is under 2 years of age.
7. When the individual is engaged in an activity that cannot be performed while wearing a mask, such as eating and drinking, or playing an instrument.
8. When an individual is participating in high intensity aerobic or aerobic activities, including a physical education class in a well-ventilated location, and able to maintain a physical distance of 6 feet from all individuals.
9. When a child/student is participating in a sports practice activity or event, whether indoors or outdoors.

The above masking requirements shall only apply to areas of the Community Center utilized by preschool students, after school program participants and/or staff, including common areas when students and/or participants are present. Masks will not be required by other individuals using Community Center facilities that in no way coincided with preschool or after school program use, such as the banquet room or administrative offices.

**This policy is effective on 9/7/2021 and is subject to change based on CDC and Department of Health orders and guidelines.**
