Two Year Old Program

The two year old program is a nice introduction to a classroom setting and a great first opportunity, for some, to be away from their grown-ups. While in class, students are able to interact with a small group of same aged children while gaining the opportunity to be independent in their activities. The use of fun finger plays, musical experiences, stories, and games, help students gain and build valuable social confidence and independence with the support of positive encouragement and cooperative interactions. Each class period follows a semi-structured schedule that includes a set beginning, middle and end of class routine that helps support predictability for the children. In between, the students are invited to engage in 1-3 structured theme-based activities and/or art projects in groups of 1-2 children per teacher.

Some topics that we focus on throughout the preschool year include:

- Basic shape identification
- Color identification
- Sorting
- Counting objects up to 5
- First initial tracing & writing
- First name identification

During each class period, the students have a small snack which provides additional opportunity to build social skills like taking turns, using manners, following directions and cleaning up.

The two year old class operates with 6 children, 1 teacher and 1 teacher's aide.
